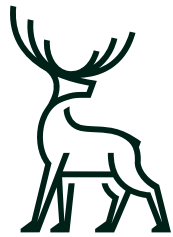

## TEA MENU

### The Torridon Signature Blend

The Torridon signature blend is a wonderfully balanced and robust tea which can be enjoyed throughout the day, on its own, or as the ideal accompaniment to a good hearty Scottish breakfast or a delicious afternoon tea indulgence. The tea develops a deep reddish-brown infusion with a rich and creamy taste with slightly sweet and flowery notes.

### Assam Bargang

Assam Bargang tea comes from an estate located on the north banks of the Brahmaputra river in the Sonipur district in Northern India. The leaves are broken with tippy heads, which helps to give it a strong and creamy infusion, and is perfect for those looking for a more powerful Assam brew.

### Lapsang Souchong

These teas are a specialty of Fujian Province in China. The leaves are put through several stages of preparation which culminates in the teas being hung in baskets over smoking pine wood fires to dry. The leaves consequently become intensely black and have a distinctly smoky aroma. The leaves have so much flavour that they can be used for two to three separate infusions.

### Darjeeling Goomtee 2nd Flush

Goomtee is ranked among the top gardens in the Darjeeling district in India and produces luscious green leaves with hues ranging from oaky-brown to light green. This tea offers a deliciously smooth and refreshing cup with distinctive muscatel characteristics.

### Earl Grey

One of the most widely drunk teas in the world, this is a blend of Chinese black tea and essential oil of bergamot which provides that beautiful aroma and flowery citrus flavour.

### Jasmine Chun Hao

Jasmine Chu Hao is a high quality green tea that has been hand rolled using tender leaves from high mountain tea bushes. This tea has an enticingly sweet and floral aroma and a delicious and invigorating flavour.

### Lung Ching

Lung Ching or 'Dragon Fountain', is a popular tea from China which produces a light, soft and slightly fruity infusion with a distinctive green tea taste.

### Peppermint

Peppermint is well known for being a fantastic digestive and also a circulatory stimulant i.e. promoting perspiration which can also help overcome flu and fever. Peppermint's decongestant properties can help with catarrhal congestion, cold relief and headaches.

### Aching Muscles Tea

A deliciously refreshing herbal infusion where a subtle mellowness of chamomile flowers combines smoothly with a zesty twist of lemongrass and invigorating spearmint to create a light and stimulating tea with a yellow cup and complex aroma. This infusion is thought to be ideal for aching or strained muscles. You should avoid this infusion during pregnancy.

### White Apricot

A Gold Taste Award winning fusion tea that combines the refined character of a white tea with the honey like sweetness of apricot pieces. The flowery undertones of marigold and rose round off the flavour, creating a truly delightful and refreshing tea.

### Lemon Verbena

Lemon verbena, known and used in European cuisine since the 17th century, is believed to be a great tonic for the nerves and also known to aid digestion. Its therapeutic effect on the body helps to create a sense of well-being, whereas its highly aromatic flavour is reminiscent of liquorice and camphor with a distinct lemon after-taste.

### Chamomile Flowers

Our award winning chamomile Flowers tea develops a yellow-golden infusion with delicious sweet honey undertones. It is an all-time favourite when it comes to calming the nerves, soothing irritability and relieving pain in the digestive system. It is believed to have anti-inflammatory and anti-septic properties. Traditionally it has been known to ease colds and flu, symptoms associated to allergy, cystitis and eczema.
