
THE 101 BEST HOTELS IN THE WORLD



THE TORRIDON *Wester Ross, UK*

For off-grid glamour, look no further than the UK's most northerly five-star hotel, a red-brick, turreted beauty buried deep in the Highlands. The interiors here charm you with their jewel tones and abundance of wood (not to mention some fabulous and colourful cornicing). And nowhere is this more evident than in the drawing room, library and two restaurants. In 1887, chef Danny Young does miraculous things with scallops, turbot and venison; in the less formal and more lively Bo & Muc brasserie, such local dishes as Scottish mozzarella and slow-cooked Beinn Eighe venison curry are served with verve. For a nightcap? Head for the cosy bar-lounge, a whisky wonderland stocked with 365 classic and rare malts, as well as its own Arcturus gin distilled on the premises. Should you yearn for even more space and soul-stirring seclusion, you can hole up in the two-bedroomed Boathouse and admire the loch from your terrace. Adventures are always encouraged, and guests can explore the three great mountain ranges to the north – each one boasting two Munros – yomping from Liathach to Beinn Eighe and Beinn Alligin. *Doubles from £462, including breakfast (thetorridon.com).*
